Beloved,



# Juneteenth at FPCG





On July 16th, we gathered after service for a Juneteenth celebration. Juneteenth is the commemoration of June 19, 1865, when 2.000 Union soldiers finally made it to Galveston Bay, TX. Even though the Emancipation Proclamation went into effect in 1863, it took until 1864 for the Thirteenth Amendment to be passed, thereby making the proclamation law. However, there were still states under Confederate control and the news of the Emancipation Proclamation was not shared by the Confederacy; it took Union soldiers physically arriving in TX in order for people to know that slavery was abolished. Slavery was legal in the US for over two hundred years, and it has only been one hundred and fifty-nine years since the original Juneteenth, which is sometimes called the US' second independence day.

Thank you to Rev. Dr. Cheni Khonje, Eileen Jones, and Contina Lee Lundy for planning a wonderful celebration, and thank you to a host of volunteers for lending a helping hand. There was good food, fellowship, and information about the history of Juneteenth, as well as activities for all ages.

We look forward to making this an FPCG tradition.
